



History

Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College





Adorned by the noble shrine of Hazrat Shah Jalal at the backdrop of exquisite tea gardens, Sylhet M.A.G. Osmani Medical College (SOMC) was established in 1962 at the majestic city of Sylhet in Bangladesh.

With its attached thousand bed hospital, the college serves the entire north-east of Bangladesh and hosts students from home and abroad.

The college was renamed to its current form in 1986 from the original "Sylhet Medical College" at the honor of late General Muhammad Ataul Gani Osmani, a native of Sylhet and a decorated national hero, who successfully led the liberation war in 1971.

The college offers many courses in various disciplines including five years graduate course leading to Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery (MBBS) and five years post graduate course leading to Doctor of Medicine (MD). In January 1993 the collage was recognized by the General Medical council of U.K.

First batch graduated in 1968. Both fourth and fifth batches graduated in 1972 due to the ongoing liberation war that led to the bloody birth of Bangladesh. Sylhet M.A.G. Osmani Medical College is affiliated with Shahjalal University of Science and Technology (SUST) under the School of Medical Sciences. Previously, it was affiliated with the University of Chittagong.

This prestigious institution is very well known to produce fine doctors who go on to become leading health care providers, scholars and academics around the globe. Their presence and contributions to the North American communities in particular are quite palpable.

Sylhet M.A.G. Osmani Medical College Alumni Association, North America (SOMCAANA) was established in 2003 to re-affirm the association between the college and its former students and to take it to newer heights.

SOMCAANA members pay frequent visits to the college as guest speakers and help introduce educational, technological and other advancements in modern medicine. They also provide active support through seminars, workshops, merit awards and the likes.




















































Report



Secretary Report: 2017-2018
